Site Supervisors Safety Training Scheme Refresher

Overview:

Existing Site Supervisors who already hold a certificate that is due to expire can sit the SSSTS Refresher course to refresh their knowledge on health, safety, welfare and environmental issues, as well as their legal responsibilities to supervise effectively. Build UK (formerly the United Kingdom Contractors Group - UKCG) recognises the SSSTS course as meeting the required standard for all supervisors working on their sites.

Who should attend:

Site supervisors or those with supervisory responsibilities who currently hold an existing 2 day SSSTS within the scope of renewal requirements would benefit from the SSSTS Refresher course.

Aims and Objectives:

The SSSTS Refresher course aims to ensure that all those given supervisory responsibilities understand:

- Why they are carrying out their identified duties
- What is expected of them and to ensure that they contribute to the safety of the workplace

Outcomes:

On successful completion of the SSSTS Refresher course, delegates will:

- Understand the problems of the industry
- Have an understanding of how health and safety law is structured and how it applies to supervisors
- Identify how their supervisory role fits in with the management structure in controlling the site safely
- Carry out risk assessments and understand the need for method statements
- Carry out effective site inductions, toolbox talks and method statement briefings
- Be able to monitor site activities effectively
- Understand the importance of timely intervention when bad practice is identified.

Course Duration: 1 Day

Certification: CITB Site Safety Plus Certificate

Certification for this course is valid for 5 years.
