

First Aid at Work Requalification

(Inhouse or NUCO Accredited)

Overview

The Emergency First Aid at Work Requalification course is a 2-day course that re-validates the First Aid at Work certificate you will already hold for a further three years.

The course includes scenario training for several workplace First Aid incidents providing the learner with the hands-on skills required to manage and take control of First Aid at their organisation.

Course Contents

- Understand the role and responsibilities of the first aider
- Assess an emergency situation safely
- Provide first aid for a casualty who is unresponsive and breathing normally
- Provide first aid for a casualty who is suffering a seizure
- Provide first aid for a casualty who is unresponsive and not breathing normally
- Place AED pads correctly
- Provide first aid to a casualty who is suffering from shock
- Provide first aid to a casualty with external bleeding
- Manage a casualty with a minor injury
- Recognise a casualty who is choking
- Conduct a secondary survey
- Administer first aid to a casualty with injuries to bones, muscles and joints
- Administer first aid to a casualty with suspected head and spinal injuries
- Administer first aid to a casualty with suspected chest injuries
- Administer first aid to a casualty with burns and scalds
- Explain the factors that affect the severity of burns and scalds
- Administer first aid to a casualty with an eye injury
- · Administer first aid to a casualty with sudden poisoning
- Administer first aid to a casualty with anaphylaxis
- Provide first aid to a casualty with suspected major illness
