The NEBOSH Health and Safety Management for Construction (UK) qualification is aimed at managers, supervisors and anybody who manages construction health and safety as part of their duties.

- Controlling workplace hazards (NCC1)
- Construction law and management.
- Construction site-Hazards and risk Control
- Vehicle and plant movement Hazards and Risk Control
- Musculoskeletal & Work equipment hazards and risk control
- Electrical safety & Fire Safety
- Chemical and biological health Hazards and risk control
- Physical and psychological health Hazards and risk control
- Working at heights hazards and risk control
- Excavation work and confined spaces Hazards and risk control
- Demolition and deconstruction hazards and risk Control
- Construction Health and safety practical application (NCC2)
- To carry out, unaided, a safety inspection of a workplace, identifying the more common hazards, deciding whether they are adequately controlled and, where necessary, suggesting appropriate and cost-effective control measures
