Health and Safety Management for Construction (UK)

Overview:

The NEBOSH Health and Safety Management for Construction (UK) qualification is aimed at managers, supervisors and anybody who manages construction health and safety as part of their duties.

The objectives of this course is to:

- To meet requirements of NEBOSH National Certificate in Construction Health & Safety
- To develop the knowledge of the individual working in construction related activities.
- To develop and enhance skills, knowledge and ability needed for those who work within construction industry or for outdoor events ie: music, theatre productions, trade exhibitions etc.

Course summary:

The qualification is divided into three units, each of which is assessed separately:

- Management of Health and Safety (NGC1)
- Foundations in Health and Safety
- Health and Safety management system's (PLAN, DO,CHECK,ACT)
- Controlling workplace hazards (NCC1)
- Construction law and management.
- Construction site-Hazards and risk Control
- Vehicle and plant movement – Hazards and Risk Control
- Musculoskeletal & Work equipment hazards and risk control
- Electrical safety & Fire Safety
- Chemical and biological health – Hazards and risk control
- Physical and psychological health – Hazards and risk control
- Working at heights – hazards and risk control
- Excavation work and confined spaces – Hazards and risk control
- Demolition and deconstruction – hazards and risk Control
- Construction Health and safety practical application (NCC2)
- To carry out, unaided, a safety inspection of a workplace, identifying the more common hazards, deciding whether they are adequately controlled and, where necessary, suggesting appropriate and cost-effective control measures
