The aim of the course is to:

Assess delegates on their skills and knowledge to perform operative duties to the standards prescribed by CABWI in-line with the NRSW Act 1991, in order to safeguard themselves and others.

Who Should attend?

The NRSW course is designed to assess and qualify experienced operatives.

Course summary:

The NRSWA training course content includes:

- LA - Location and avoidance of underground apparatus.
- O1 - Signing, lighting and guarding.
- O2 - Excavation in the highway.
- O3 - Reinstatement of compaction and backfill materials.
- O4 - Reinstatement of sub-base and road base non-bituminous materials.
- O5- Reinstatement and Compaction of cold lay bituminous materials.
- O6- Reinstatement and Compaction of hot lay bituminous materials.
- O8 – Reinstatement of Modular surfaces and Concrete footways.

By the end of the NRSWA course delegates will be able to:

- Summarise the requirements of the current NRSW Act.
- Select appropriate personal protective and safety equipment as required to carry out street works activities.
- Provide a safe working environment for themselves and others.
