



## NRSWA 5 DAYS - SUPERVISOR COURSE

### **The aim of the course is to:**

Assess delegates on their skills and knowledge to perform Supervisor duties to the standards prescribed by CABWI in-line with the NRSW Act 1991, in order to safeguard themselves and others.

### **Who Should attend?**

The NRSW course is designed to assess and qualify experienced supervisors.

### **Course summary:**

The NRSWA training course content includes:

- LA - Location and avoidance of underground apparatus.
- S1 - Monitoring Signing, Lighting and Guarding.
- S2 - Monitoring Excavation in the highway.
- S3 - Monitoring Reinstatement of compaction and backfill materials.
- S4 - Monitoring Reinstatement of sub-base and road base non-bituminous materials.
- S5 - Monitoring of Bituminous Materials
- S7 - Monitoring Reinstatement of Modular surfaces and Concrete footways.

### **By the end of the NRSWA course delegates will be able to:**

- Summarise the requirements of the current NRSW Act.
- Select appropriate personal protective and safety equipment as required to carry out street works activities.
- Supervisors will be able to monitor duties performed by Operatives for each unit and/or qualification Standards in-line with current legislation, and ACOP where applicable.
- Provide a safe working environment for themselves and others.
