

# NRSWA – NOVICE SIGNING, LIGHTING & GUARDING

## **Operatives (O1)**

#### The aim of the course is to:

Provide novice Operatives with the skills and knowledge to carry out Signing Lighting and Guarding inline with the current NRSW Act to safeguard themselves and others.

### Who Should attend?

This Signing, Lighting and Guarding training programme is designed for Operatives who must set up traffic lights, barriers and cones on the roads and highways. This two-day option is aimed at novice or less experienced candidates and includes training and assessment. (Please note this course is for operative only).
