The aim of the course is to:

Assess both experienced Operatives on their skills and knowledge to carry out Signing, Lighting and Guarding in-line with the current NRSW Act to safeguard themselves and others.

Who Should attend?

This signing, lighting and guarding assessment programme is designed for operatives who must set up traffic lights, barriers and cones on the roads and highways.

This one-day option is aimed at experienced candidates and is an assessment only programme.
