



Permit To Work

Aims of the course:

By the end of this course, you will:

- Understand what types of work may require a permit-to-work and why.
- Know who is responsible for preparing and issuing permits.
- Understand the duties that managers, supervisors and workers have under permit-to-work systems.
- Know what information a permit-to-work should contain.
- Be aware of what personnel must do before permits are issued, when they are in place, and when the work is completed.
- Understand the importance of ensuring that all those affected by the work activities covered in the permit-to-work understand the controls and procedures, and are trained and instructed correctly.
- Understand the importance of emergency procedures and how they relate to the permit-to-work.

Who Should attend?

Anyone who will be creating and issuing permits, as well as those who will supervise or carry out the work covered by a permit. It explains the duties of everyone responsible for the permit, from the point of issue to the work's completion.
