

Ride-on Roller

The aim of the course is to:

Provide delegates with the knowledge and skills that will enable them to safely and competently operate a Ride on Roller.

The objectives of the course are to enable delegates to:

- Be able to operate the machine safely and correctly in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and accepted good practice.
- Carry out a pre-start inspection.
- Be able to operate safely under varying site conditions.
- Be able to carry out minor adjustments and routine services.
- Have an understanding of responsibilities under Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 & other current relevant legislation.

Course summary:

Upon successful completion of the course, candidates will have gained practical skills and knowledge to:

- Have a basic understanding of the industry, the dangers of working in the industry and their responsibilities as an operator.
- Have a working knowledge of the manufacturer's handbook for the particular machine to be used.
- Be able to locate and identify the major components of the machine and explain their functions.
- Be able to locate and identify key controls and explain their functions.
- Conduct all pre-operational checks in accordance with manufacturer's and legislative requirements.
- Identify and maintain PPE appropriate for roller use.
- Prepare the roller for use and operate machinery safely and efficiently.
- Conduct all necessary safety checks at the work area.
- Operate machinery safely and efficiently.
- Environmental considerations
- Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of loading and unloading procedures for machine transportation.
- Carry out all end of shift and shut down procedures.
