Sling and Signal for Lifting Operations

The aim of the course is to:

Provide delegates with the knowledge and skills that will enable them to safely and competently operate as a Slinger Signaller.

The Objectives of the Course are to enable delegates to:

- Establish the weight and dimensions of loads and communicate this information to the crane operator
- Select, attach and detach appropriate lifting tackle
- Direct the actions of a crane moving loads by giving clear signals to ensure safety of personnel and plant
- Determine the serviceability of tackle and how to maintain and store it correctly
- Have an understanding of responsibilities under Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 & other current relevant legislation
